# THROUGH THE LENS OF MATTHEW PATRICK SMYTH

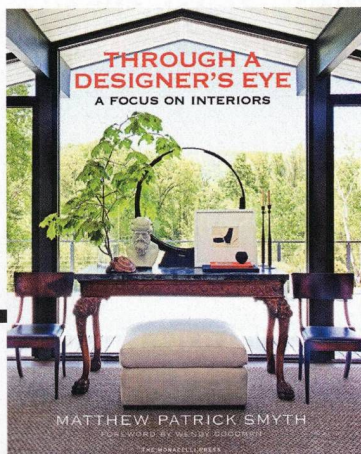
**F**rom a Park Avenue duplex to a historic Palm Beach home by architect Maurice Fatio to the designer's own 1970s country house in Salisbury, Connecticut, **Matthew Patrick Smyth's** newest book, *Through a Designer's Eye: Focus on Interiors* (The Monacelli Press), showcases his impeccably designed classic interiors, presented in a first-person narrative that relates how he has rediscovered his love

of photography in the age of the smartphone, giving readers a true glimpse through the designer's eye.
